

Where Can You Park?

Parking lot availability has changed this year from what you may remember. The lot at the corner of Monroe Avenue and Ridge Row is now the site of a building under construction. There are some new options available for parking. Here is what you should know.

You can park in the Parking Pavillion, #68 on the campus map. If you choose to park there, please do not park in spaces reserved for faculty. If you do, you risk being ticketed by campus police.

Street parking along Clay Avenue has also been eliminated. A green space now exists where the street once was.

A new lot is available at the corner of North Webster Avenue and Linden Street. It is "I" on the map, across the street from building 47, Condron Hall. Those staying in Condron or Gavigan Halls can use Mahon Court, located between the two buildings for loading and unloading. Mahon Court runs between Mulberry and Linden Streets.

Another new lot is located along Ridge Row. Look for the black circle with the letter "C" on the map.

Although we will not be using Redington Hall this year, the parking lot behind it is also available. It is shown on the map by the letter "G" inside the black circle.
